San Antonio Pinot Grigio, Italy	£18.95
<i>Delicate colour, this light bodied Pinot Grigio has a ripe fruit aroma with pear and melon flavours on the palate. Crisp and dry, it has balanced acidity with a long lingering finish.</i>	
Martinez Lacuesta Rioja Blanco, Spain	£19.95
<i>A hugely aromatic wine. A fantastic freshness and vivacity comes through with an additional handful of lavish fruit.</i>	
Muscadet sur Lie, Langlois Chateau, France	£22.50
<i>Typical of how decent Chablis should taste - not a trace of oak, flinty on the nose with a tad of creamy fruit underneath.</i>	
Macon La Roche Vineuse, Chanson, France	£29.95
<i>Pale gold colour. Notes of orange blossom mixed with aromas of lemon and yellow fruits enhanced by subtle minerality. Generous, well-balanced with a good density. Long and citrusy aftertaste.</i>	

Juicy and Fruit Driven

Caoba Viognier, Argentina	£18.95
<i>A lighter, yet full flavoured style of Viognier. The nose leaps out of the glass with aromas of ripe stone fruit. Flavours of peach and apricot are followed by a subtle sweet spice with a lingering finish.</i>	
Domaine Astruc Reserve Chardonnay, France	£20.95
<i>It has a light pale gold colour with intense aromas of tropical and dry fruits with a pleasant hints of vanilla on the finish.</i>	
Gavi di Gavi Nuovo Quadro, Italy	£26.50
<i>An enticing nose of white peach and pear with hints of fresh lime and gooseberry. Fresh and zesty citrus notes and ripe peachy characters are balanced by crisp acidity and mineral notes leading to a textured complex finish.</i>

<i>Grassy aromas with strong aromatic grapefruit flavours then a crisp and appealing finish with fresh acidity.</i>	
Grand Cape Chenin Blanc, South Africa	£17.95
<i>A fresh, dry Chenin with broad appeal displaying classic baked apple and zippy citrus aromas with soft, delicate apple fruit on the palate well balanced by crisp acidity.</i>	
Whitehaven Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand	£22.95
<i>Beautifully balanced with fantastic tropical fruit flavours and a clean fresh citric finish.</i>	
Spyro Albarino, Spain	£27.95
<i>The whites from the lesser known Galicia are rightly gaining a strong international reputation. This example is full of crisp fruit.</i>	
Chateau Fontaine-Audon Sancerre, France	£37.95
<i>An intense nose of grapefruit and passion fruit. Full fresh elegant palate with a mineral finish.</i>	
Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand	£42.95
<i>Layers of pure, bracing fruit flavours on the palate finish with terrific intensity and length.</i>

<i>Deep and generous. Beautiful fruit. Delicate minerality and tense acidity. Long and refreshing finish.</i>	
Montagny Premier Cru, Chanson, France	£45.00
<i>Pale gold colour. Fragrances of honeysuckle mixed with aromas of citrus fruit. Well structured. Dense with a tight texture and a well-defined minerality. Long and refreshing aftertaste.</i>	
Chablis Premier Cru, Chanson, France	£45.00
<i>Bright gold colour. Very fresh aromas of lemon and white fruit. Delicate vanilla note. Beautiful mineral expression. Taut and linear. Sappy with a well-crafted acidity. Refreshing aftertaste with a lingering minerality.</i>	
Puligny Montrachet Premier Cru, Chanson, France	£85.00
<i>Fragrances of lime blossom mixed with citrus fruit and honey with a hint of minerality and subtle oak notes.</i>

Riviera Pinot Noir, France	£19.95
<i>An excellent young Pinot Noir, with good weight of fruit. Strawberries, raspberries and redcurrants on the nose and palate with lively acidity.</i>	
Newen Pinot Noir, Bodega del fin del Mundo, Patagonia	£26.50
<i>Very fruity aroma with notes of Morello cherries, cherries and caramel. A touch of vanilla and coconut. Sweet and fruity with soft tannins, silky and balanced. Long after taste.</i>	
Fleurie La Madonne, Chanson, France	£28.95
<i>A heady perfume of freshly picked irises and peonies drift above the crushed berry fruit nose. Ripe tannins and fresh acidity support a palate of Morello cherries and Black Forest Gateaux.</i>	

Rich and Full Bodied

Domaine Astruc Shiraz Viognier, Paul Mas, France	£22.50
<i>Hints of spice and red fruits on the nose with clean bright, juicy strawberry compote and cream flavours as well as dry earthy notes on the palate. This is well balanced with fine soft tannins and a long dry finish.</i>	
False Bay Pinotage, South Africa	£22.95
<i>A heady perfume of freshly picked irises and peonies drift above the crushed berry fruit nose. Ripe tannins and fresh acidity support a palate of Morello cherries and Black Forest Gateaux.</i>	
Mesoneros de Castilla, Spain	£29.50
<i>Layered rich fruit with toasty black-fruited notes from some time in oak. Good length and supple tannins give an ample, richly-flavoured finish.</i>	
The Lackey Shiraz, Kilikanoon, Australia	£30.95
<i>Big and black with tarry black fruit and lots of toasty oak and a black pepper finish.</i>	
Puglia Rosso IGT Appassimento, Italy	£32.95
<i>A rich, complex and fruity wine, with notes of ripe dark cherries, fresh herbs and vanilla.</i>	
Terrazas Malbec, Argentina	£35.95
<i>Intense, purplish colour with red shades. Very expressive, revealing a floral and red fruit profile of violet, raspberry and cherry, with marked aromas of toasted coffee and chocolate.</i>	

Juicy Medium Bodied

San Perito Merlot, Chile	£16.95
<i>The nose has the peppery edge and the palate shows dark fruits and ripe cherry flavours with a hint of chocolate and coffee.</i>	
Don Placero Rioja Tinto, Spain	£18.95
<i>Dark red colour, tannic, full bodied red with intense berry aroma, and lengthy aftertaste.</i>	
Flagtree Merlot Malbec Cabernet Sauvignon, Bodega del fin del Mundo, Patagonia	£19.50
<i>Fruity aroma with hints of blackberries and plum jam, tobacco and smoke. On the palate, the wine is very fruity, pleasant, round and well balanced with a long aftertaste.</i>	
Postales Malbec, Bodega del fin del Mundo, Patagonia	£21.95
<i>Dark red violet. Fruity, reminiscent of red fruit and plum jam, with notes of vanilla and tobacco. On the palate, it is gentle and fruity, with the presence of tannins giving great structure and a pronounced finish. Soft and balanced.</i>	
Côtes du Rhône, Chapoutier, France	£25.50
<i>Well-structured, with soft tannins. A nice spicy finish for a typical "Côtes du Rhône".</i>	
Chateau Petit Bois Lussac Saint-Emilion, France	£31.50
<i>A nose of ripe red fruits with a distinct strawberry suggestion. The palate is balanced, upright and delivers the same crisp aromas.</i>	
Crozes Hermitage Organic, M. Chapoutier, France	£39.95
<i>Pronounced aromas of summer fruits such as blackcurrants and raspberries. It's fresh and soft on the palate with juicy summer-pudding flavours and a whiff of black pepper.</i>

Wines of Elegance

Chateau Musar, Lebanon	£55.00
<i>The nose is aromatic, fragrant, warm and mellow and it prepares the palate for fruits of cherries, strawberries and redcurrants. The palate is full of these fruits and combined with soft tannins, the wine is very well balanced.</i>	
Gevrey Chambertin, Vallet Freres, France	£55.00
<i>Delicate sweet strawberry fruit, fresh acidity and a clean, vibrant palate. A restrained style, with elegance and a savoury, autumnal finish.</i>	
Château de Pez Saint-Estephe, France	£62.50
<i>The nose has the peppery edge and the palate shows dark fruits and ripe cherry flavours with a hint of chocolate and coffee.</i>	
Numanthia, Spain	£75.00
<i>Both intense and complex, there are several layers of aromatics in this lively nose: first some extremely intense notes of red and black fruits, perfectly integrated with sweet spices vanilla and toasted characters.</i>	
Chateau Patache, Pomerol, France	£99.00
<i>A plump, bold wine, which exhibits all the rich fruit you expect from a truly great Merlot. Depth is contributed by notes of dark chocolate and mocha, and fine-grained tannins intimate good ageing potential.</i>	
Cheval des Andes, Argentina	£99.00
<i>Inky black and opulent, this ultra-powerful wine offers concentrated violets, brooding dark fruit and vanilla on the nose and a huge, yet supple full finish and long length.</i>	
Chateau Tayac, Margaux 2010, France	£72.95
<i>Fresh and plummy, warm and soft with a good core of fruit, very polished and lots of potential with well-integrated oak on the finish.</i>	

Rose Wines

San Antonio Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy	£17.95
<i>Very light and refreshing with a delicate pear-drop fruit. Absolutely bright and fresh, terrifically easy to drink.</i>	
Martinez Lacuesta Rioja Rosado, Spain	£18.50
<i>Bright pink in colour, it has a great intensity of aroma of roses, strawberries and a slight hint of mandarin citrus.</i>	
Cabernet de Saumur Rosé, Langlois-Chateau, France	£23.50
<i>Salmon-pink in colour with a nose of fresh red fruit and sour candies. Deliciously juicy on the palette, fruity and long-lasting.</i>	
MiMi Rosé, France	£26.50
<i>A fresh and well-balanced wine, light pink in colour with a pleasant after taste that lingers nicely. Flowery notes reminiscent of the flavours of crushed strawberry, lemon and watermel- on.</i>
